## Overview:

*Who are we and what are we here for?*

*Do I have to be a cross-cultural overseas missionary for me to participate in God's mission?*

*What does my study, work or family life have to do with God's mission?*

*What about social justice and care for creation?*

Using Christopher Wright's book, *The Mission of God's People*, we will learn together how to be missional people who participate in God's mission in all spheres of our daily lives. The two main questions we will address and answer together are: Who are we (our identity)? And what are we here for (our mission)? This training will provide you with a comprehensive and holistic vision of God's mission for God's people in God's world. We will incorporate reading and discussion, prayer and practice through which we anticipate the transformation of our life--head, heart and hands. The cohort will be limited to 12 people and will be facilitated by Pastor Charles Lee and Elder John Im.

## Expectations:

1. Bi-weekly meeting to discuss a chapter from the book.
2. Each participant presents a chapter from the book at least once.
3. Each member will be part of a small group within the cohort to do life to life discipleship and keep each other accountable and supported.
4. Missional expedition/practice together during and after the 16-week sessions.
5. Reflection paper/testimony at the end of the training.
